- Clean tools immediately after use with water

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Step 1:

Dig out or prepare area that the screenings will be placed to the approx depth of 75mm.

Step 2:

Spread out the screenings evenly across area required.

Step 3:

Level the surface with a rake or screed.

Step 4:

Lightly water surface to remove any dirt.

If you wish to use the screenings in concrete please follow the mix formula below:

- 1 part cement.
- 2.5 parts sand.
- 2.5 parts screenings.

Important Consumer Information: Please read safe handling & usage advice before opening bag.

HAZARDOUS: When mixed with Portland & Blended Cements.

Contents: Screenings (blue metal aggregate stones). Crystalline Silica <1%. Non-hazardous ingredients to 100%.

Note: Crystalline Silica, (quartz), is present as an impurity.

Risk: Cement dust may cause respiratory, skin and eye irritation.

Wet cements can be irritating and corrosive to the eyes and skin; and may cause skin sensitisation (dermatitis). Repeated inhalation of dust containing crystalline silica may cause bronchitis, silicosis (scarring of the lung) and lung cancer, & increases the risk of Scleroderma.

Safety: Avoid contact with eyes and skin from both wet and dry cement. Do not breathe in dust. Wear suitable protective clothing, including gloves or barrier cream, foot wear and eye protection. Wear a P1 or P2 dust mask suitable for particulates when exposed to dust. When cutting or abrading concrete keep it wet with water to avoid creation of hazardous dust. Always wear suitable protective clothing and respiratory protection. Wash thoroughly after handling. Wash work clothes regularly.

First Aid: Irrigate eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes and seek medical attention. If inhaled remove from dusty area. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist. Wash skin with water.

Spills/Leaks: Keep out of sewers and storm water.

Disposal: Follow above safety instructions and collect in containers for disposal as trade waste in accordance with local authority guidelines.

Manual Handling: Cement bags (16-40kg) are heavy, lifting them without due care and attention can result in personal injury. Unless you are trained in manual handling of heavy loads, it is best you share the load with another person.
